FEAST OF ST FRANCIS XAVIER

The Triduum celebrations for the Feast of St Francis Xavier will begin at the 5.30 pm Mass on Sunday, 1 Dec. Mass on Monday, 2 Dec, and Tuesday, 3 Dec, will be at 7.30 pm. The Litany of St Francis Xavier will be prayed 15 minutes before all the Masses. Rev Fr Arnel Aguino SJ, liturgical music composer and assistant professor of systematic theology at the Loyola School of Theology in Ateneo de Manila University, will be presiding at this Triduum.

Morning Mass will be at the usual times on all 3 days of the Triduum. There will be a fellowship gathering immediately after the 7.30 pm Mass on Tuesday, 3 December.
