a) **4 May** b) **6 July** c) **5 October**

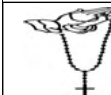
Each session will run for **7 Sundays**.

Proper Care & Disposal of Sacramentals

Sacramentals can be described as holy objects blessed by the Church for the purpose of sanctifying lives and guiding individuals towards the sacraments.

They act as sacred signs providing grace (spiritual help) through the intercession of the Church. Examples include scapulars, medals, candles, holy pictures, rosaries, crucifixes, statues, and other items blessed with holy water by a priest.



Once a religious object is blessed and dedicated for divine worship or veneration, it must be treated with reverence and must not be used in either an improper or profane way (cf. Code of Canon Law, #1171).

What happens when the rosary, crucifix or statue breaks and is irreparable?

- The respectful and proper way is to either burn or bury them. If possible, the ashes together with any remaining bits unburnt should be collected and then buried.
- If a person is unable to do either, the sacramental may be dropped off at the parish office.
